Applicants must have graduated, or be proposing to graduate in the current academic year, with Honours 1 or equivalent from a recognised institution.

Citizens of New Zealand will only be considered for UPA awards.

Applicants must have graduated, or be proposing to graduate in the current academic year, with Honours 1 or 2/1 from a recognised institution.

✓ Open to Australian citizens, New Zealand citizens, and Australian permanent residents.

Female applicants only.

Applicants must have graduated, or be proposing to graduate in the current academic year, with a Bachelor of Engineering degree, with Honours 1 or 2/1 from a recognised institution.

Enrolment in Session One 2006 in a full-time PhD research program in the Faculty of Engineering at UNSW.
